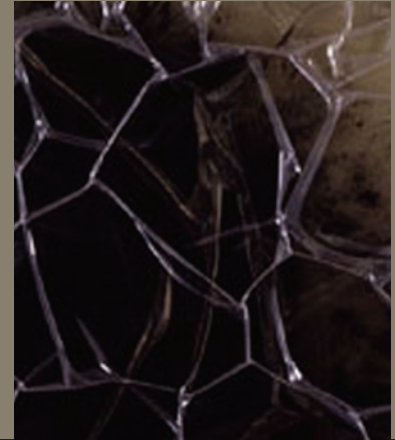

Unlike polyester silver halide film (which has a life expectancy of 500 years!), acetate film can and often does decay. Within years, it can become entirely unusable.
